## Cutting Edge Quiltworks Class Policy

1. Please sign up for the class in advance. Not doing so could mean the class will be cancelled because we do not have the minimum number of students required by the teacher.
2. We require a deposit of  $\frac{1}{2}$  the class fee at sign up with the remainder due before class day.
3. We strive to have available the supplies that are suggested and/or required by the teachers for your class. All supplies from the class supply list will be given a 15% discount. Please let your Cutting Edge Staff Member know you are purchasing for a class. They can help you make sure you have everything.
4. You will be given a 15% class discount on any purchases made on your class day. (Not including class fees, long-arm quilting or special orders.)
5. If we must cancel a class all fees will be refunded.
6. If you must cancel a class please give us as much notice as possible. If you cancel 48 hours prior to the class your fee will be refunded by store credit, which can be applied to purchases, classes or long-arm machine quilting. We are unable to refund fees for students who are "no-shows".
